Priority 1: Income Eligible, Electric Heat

50% assistance up to 1,500 kWh max per month, November through April – MAX ASSISTANCE = \$101.25

1. Low Income
2. Electric Heat source as primary

Priority 2: Income Eligible, Non-Electric Heat

50% assistance up to 1,000 kWh max per month, November through April - MAX ASSISTANCE = \$67.50

1. Low Income
2. Non-electric Heat source as primary
